The course includes both theory and multiple driving sessions with Maserati's top-performing models. Both the 550-CV GranTurismo Trofeo and 630-CV MC20 super sports car are powered by the revolutionary, 3-liter, twin-turbo V6 Nettuno engine.

Throughout the day, our team of professional instructors will work closely with you to analyze your performance. They will review driving parameters such as steering angle, braking pressure, gear shift patterns and throttle use, to help you advance across the board. By the end of the day, you'll be amazed to see how much your driving has improved and how the gap between your actual lap and ideal lap has shrunk.

This day-long training program climaxes in three challenges:

- The drag racing contest, where participants compete side by side along the main straight of the circuit in an acceleration test:
- The GT drive contest, where driving skills are measured against the chronometer;
- Simulator training a virtual training experience where you can gauge your speed with driving simulators.

The GT Race Simulation is the final step to live the thrill of a GT competition as co-drivers on board the MC20. At the end of a riveting day on the track, the drivers with the best rankings will receive awards during a closing ceremony, rounding out the experience with one final rush of emotion.

## **FULL DAY PROGRAM**

8.45 am Arrival at the circuit and registration of participants

9.00 am Essential theory session focused on:

- Driving seat position and correct use of the car's controls
- Racing lines
- Braking procedures
- Visual targeting
- 9.30 am Warm up sessions: start of dynamic activities

Demonstration lap with a professional driver, followed by each participant's first driving session. Circuit familiarization: braking zones, racing lines, points of acceleration out of corners.

10.30 am Split of participants in groups.

The track sessions will be alternated with the training sessions at the simulator and with the GT driving contest throughout the day

The participants will take turns in multiple driving sessions with MC20 and GranTurismo Trofeo, with onboard video and data recording. The telemetry data analysis allows the tutor to monitor how the exercises have been carried out and to give each participant the instruction to improve his driving performance.

- 12.30pm Buffet lunch at the circuit restaurant
- 1.30 pm Drag race contest where the participants will compete side by side, along the main straight of the circuit in an acceleration test
- 2.30 pm Re-start of the dynamic activities.

The participants will seat again behind the wheel of the MC20 and GranTurismo Trofeo, for the second session of telemetry data recording. The tutor will review the data with each driver for the final evaluation and the review of the actual improvements.

4.30 pm GT Race Simulation

the professional drivers will simulate the main phases of a real GT race with the participants sitting as passengers on board of four MC20s to live the thrill of a rolling start, fast cornering, hard braking and extreme overtaking

5.30 pm Diploma delivery & final ceremony
